2023 Conditions of Play

1. Competition shall be played in accordance with the rules of golf as adopted by the Royal and Ancient Club of St Andrews, Scotland subject to such local rules as are in force on the day on which the competition takes place.
2. The maximum handicap for Women is 45.
3. The Match Committee shall have full control of the competition and shall have the right to alter the conditions or starting times and shall also have the right to refuse entry to any person without being required to give any reason for such refusal.
4. The Match Committee will settle any disputes or protests. Such disputes or protests must be lodged no later than 15 minutes after the conclusion of play.
5. In the event of a tie or ties, the winner of the Anglesea Classic will be decided by the recommended GA countback system using all three scores as an aggregate. In the event of a tie or ties in the individual the winner will be decided by the recommended GA countback system.
6. Mobile phones: A multi-functional device may be used for scoring, provided it is not to access information that, if used, would cause the player to be in breach of Rule 4.3a. Penalty for breach of Local Rules – General Penalty (2 penalty strokes in stroke play or loss of hole in match play).
7. Caddies: The use of professional or trainee golfers as caddies is not permitted.
8. Distance measuring device: A player may obtain distance information by use of a distance measuring device. If a player uses a device to gauge or measure other conditions that might affect her play (eg: gradient, wind speed, temperature, etc) the player is in breach of Rule 4.3a.
9. GA Handicap and Golf Link numbers will be needed on the day of play.
10. A player can only play for one club on the day.
11. The Committee may, in the event of bad weather, or for any other reason, either shorten the contest or reschedule on another day.
