QPGC OPEN MEETING 2025 - CONDITIONS OF PLAY

- 1. Entries will be restricted to course capacity, the only entries that will be accepted will be those made on the online MiTournament booking site, with the entry fee paid. All others will be rejected.
- 2. Entries for all events will close on **Sunday 9th February 2025** (or when field capacity reached) any late entries or queries must be addressed to the Tournament Secretary (150 Queens Park Rd. Highton 3216). Email is the preferred option, please contact Jenny Hume at: open@queensparkgolfclub.com or 0458 102 414.
- 3. All handicaps will be fixed by the Tournament Committee who reserve the right to temporarily alter a player's Australian handicap in accordance with the Australian Handicapping System before any event if they deem it desirable. Maximum Australian Handicap 54 for men, 54 for women. Sunday & Monday team events: Individual players handicap will be limited to a maximum daily playing handicap of 45.
- 4. The Tournament Committee has the entire management of the meeting. In the event of ties, events will be decided on count back except for scratch events, which will be decided by a sudden death play-off from the first hole and will be decided by the Tournament Committee. Countbacks will be made as laid down by Golf Australia.
- 5. Players must report to registration 30 minutes prior to hit-off and must be prepared to play when called upon by the Starter.
- 6. Entries are restricted to amateurs who are members of Golf Australia or members of golf clubs registered with such state or overseas Associations as are affiliated with or recognised by this Association. The Committee shall have the right to refuse the entry of any person without being required to give any reason for such refusal.
- 7. Competitions shall be played in accordance with the Rules of Golf as adopted by the Royal & Ancient Golf Club of St. Andrews, Scotland together with such local rules as are in force on the course over which the competition takes place. If a dispute arises on any point, it shall be decided by the Committee in charge of the competition, whose decision shall be final. Any dispute or protest must be made to the committee within 15 minutes of the day's play.
- 8. The Committee may in the event of bad weather, or any other reason, either cancel or shorten any contest.
- 9. No player can win more than one major trophy on any one day. Exception being the Silver Salver Trophy.
- 10. Neat casual attire must be worn on the course and in the clubrooms.
- 11. Players must observe the clubs Code of Conduct.
- 12. Rule 5.6a (Pace of play) will be strictly enforced. Each group must maintain its position on the course with respect to the group preceding them. Any group with a clear hole in front of them will be considered out of position. Penalties may be issued to individuals in such groups who by their pace contribute to such delay.
- 13. Silver Salver entries to be made by club officials. Each team shall consist of 3 players who have played in events 1-5 and the team returning the lowest aggregate net score shall win the Silver Salver event. If an original member of a team be unable to play, a substitute from the club may be played. Each member of the winning team will receive a trophy. In the event of a tie the winner shall be decided on countbacks, as recommended by Golf Australia. Countbacks being the aggregate of last 9, 6 or 3 holes for the whole team.
- 14. To be eligible for SWGA Merit Award points in events 1-6, a player must indicate their SWGA Club on the entry form.
- 15. To be eligible for the SWGA Order of Merit, players must indicate their SWGA Home Club on the entry form.
- 16. All visitors to Queens Park Golf Club during the Tournament will be considered honorary members for the day.
- 17. The personal details requested from players in the entry form are for the purpose of: (a) registering players into a golf tournament as described in the form; (b) listing players names into a tournament field and publishing that field in the Club's website; (c) recording details on the club database for mailing future entry forms. On receipt of a written request by a player, to either have access to their details, or have their details deleted will be actioned.
