Event 1. Torquay Women's Open Challenge Bowl. Teams Stableford event of 18 holes.

Event 2. 18 Holes Individual Stableford (3 Divisions) played concurrently with Event No 1.

Each team shall consist of three players. The team with the best Stableford aggregate score will hold the Bowl for one year. The winning Club's name will be engraved on the Bowl, which will be retained at the Torquay Golf Club. Each member of the winning team will receive a trophy. If any original member of the team is unable to play, the Captain of the Club may substitute a female member from the same club. All team competitors will be entered in Event 2.

**TORQUAY GOLF CLUB 2026 WOMEN'S OPEN CHALLENGE BOWL
CONDITIONS OF PLAY**

- 1. The events are open to all women of Clubs affiliated with Golf Australia and who hold a Golf Australia handicap. Each Club shall be entitled to enter three teams.**
- 2. Entrance Fee must be paid at time of entry.**
- 3. Entries to be via Mitournament**
- 4. Competition to be played in accordance with the Rules of Golf as adopted by the Royal and Ancient Club of St. Andrew's, Scotland, subject to local rules in force at Torquay Golf Club. If a dispute arises at any point, it shall be decided by the Women's Match Committee of the Torquay Golf Club.**
- 5. Competitors will be drawn to play with each other in a manner the Match Committee decides, and the Match Committee reserves the right to change groups as may be required.**
- 6. The Match Committee is to make all arrangements, and to have full power to alter or amend any condition should they deem it desirable.**
- 7. Any protest must be lodged in writing at the Clubhouse before 5.00pm on the day of competition.**
- 8. The Match Committee may, in the event of extreme weather conditions, shorten the contest, suspend or cancel play or fix another day.**
- 9. In the event of a tie or ties, the winner of the Challenge Bowl will be decided by the recommended GA count-back system using all three scores as an aggregate. In the event of a tie or ties in event No 2, the winner will be decided by the recommended GA countback system.**
- 10. The use of mobile phones (except in the cases of emergency, miscore or a rules query) is prohibited.**
- 11. Caddies. The use of professional or trainee professional golfers as caddies is not permitted.**
- 12. Distance measuring device. A player may obtain distance information by use of a distance measuring device. If a player uses a device to gauge or measure other conditions that might affect her play (e.g. Elevation changes, wind speed etc.) the player is in breach of Rule 4.3a.**
- 13. The Women's Match Committee of the Torquay Golf Club shall have the right to refuse the entry of any person without being required to give a reason.**
