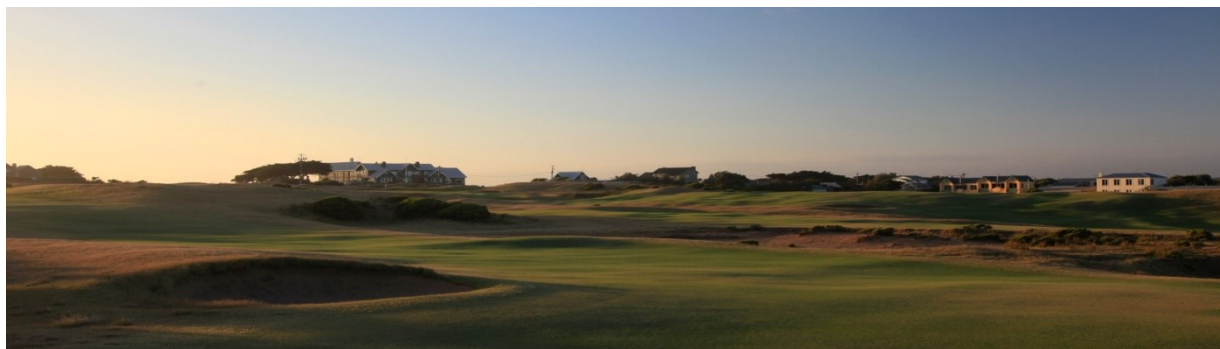

2. ENTRY FEE MUST BE PAID BY CHEQUE OR CREDIT CARD AT THE TIME OF ENTRY.
3. ENTRIES MUST BE RECEIVED NO LATER THAN WEDNESDAY, 14 FEBRUARY 2018.
4. Entrants must conform in all respects to the Rules of Amateur Status, as adopted by the Royal and Ancient Golf Club of St. Andrews. Entries shall be subject to approval by the Committee and the entrant's home club, which must be affiliated with the SWGA. The Committee shall have the right to refuse the entry of any person or team without being requested to give any reason for such refusal.
5. The competition shall be played in accordance with the Rules of Golf as are adopted by the R & A Rules Limited, Scotland, together with such local rules as are in force on the course over which the competition takes place. If a dispute should arise on any point, it shall be decided by the Committee in charge of the competition, whose decision shall be final. Provided, however, that the Committee, if in doubt, shall have the right to refer any such dispute to the Council of Golf Victoria, whose decision shall then be final.
6. The Committee shall consist of the Committee of the Barwon Heads Golf Club. In the absence of a Full Committee such Members thereof, as may be present at the time, may give a decision and the decision shall be deemed to be the decision of the Full Committee.
7. All competitors will play off their Golf Australia Handicaps.
8. Competitors will be drawn against each other for the day in such manner as the Committee may arrange, and the Committee, or such person as the Committee may authorize, shall have the power to select a partner for any Competitor whose partner is not at the first tee when called upon at the time appointed to start.
9. In the event of a tie, a count-back, using the method recommended by Golf Victoria will decide the winner, team or individual.
10. The Match Sub-Committee shall have the power to limit the number of entries and alter their starting times.
Teams must be prepared to play at any time fixed by the Committee.
11. Competitors will be made Honorary Members of the Barwon Heads Golf Club for the duration of the event.
